Permethrin is an EPA-registered insect repellent that can be applied to clothing.

When using permethrin:

- Always follow label instructions.
- Do not apply permethrin to skin.
- Do not apply to clothing while it is being worn.
- Wash permethrin-treated clothing separately from other clothes.
- Don't forget to apply insect repellent to exposed skin.
