



PA RECOGNIZED CRITICAL CARE AND AIR AMBULANCE TRANSPORT EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

Updated 11/23/2015

Under 28 Pa. Code §§ 1027.39(d) and 1027.40, (relating to critical care transport ambulance service), expansion of the applicable EMS providers' scopes of practice include EMS skills in addition to those skills included in these EMS providers' general scopes of practice that were published at 45 Pa.B. 5463 (August 29, 2015). To perform these expanded skills, EMS providers must receive education to perform these skills by having successfully completed a critical care transport educational program or air ambulance transport educational program approved by the Department. Minimum requirements to become an approved CCT educational program or air ambulance transport educational program, and a list of approved CCT educational programs and air ambulance transport educational programs, will be updated on the Department of Health website, upon review and acceptance by the Bureau of Emergency Medical Services.

Critical Care Transport Ambulance Services and Air Ambulance Services desiring recognition for a critical care transport program or air ambulance transport educational program not appearing below, may submit a program for review and approval consideration to the Department of Health.
