Dear School Nurse:

Enclosed you will find the 2014 -2015 School Immunization Law Report. This report should be completed and returned to the Department of Health, Division of Immunizations (DOI) by December 31, 2014.

The DOI is continuing to collect antigen specific data for kindergarten and 7th grade students. The first section of the report is asking for the number of students in kindergarten and 7th grades that have the number of doses indicated of that specific antigen or had the disease. Only record the students who are current with their immunizations who are in kindergarten and 7th grades. The grayed out blocks are not applicable for that particular grade.

There are specific columns for specified vaccines; DT, Polio, MMR, Hep B, Varicella (disease or vaccine), Tdap, Td and MCV. If you have knowledge of the student having received these immunizations please include them in your report.

Please complete the antigen specific section for kindergarten and 7th grade. *Column A* is the total number of students enrolled in that particular grade level. Of that total, how many of those students are medical exempt - *Column B*, religious exempt – *Column C*, philosophical/strong moral or ethical conviction exempt - *Column D*. Students enrolled provisionally until they complete their required immunizations - *Column E*. Students who are denied admission or attendance because they do not have their required immunizations will be entered in *Column F*.
