Due to an over 50% decrease in adult vaccine funding for Department supplied vaccines, there are four adult vaccines that will no longer be available beginning **April 1, 2014** and until further notice. The four vaccines are:

Twinrix (HepA/B)
Cervarix (HPV)
Menveo (Meningococcal)
Zostavax (Zoster)

The remaining Department supplied vaccines that continue to be available are listed below.

Recombivax (Hep B)
Engerix (Hep B)
Gardasil (HPV)
Menactra (Meningococcal)
MMR-II (MMR)
