



Elk County

The Department of Health is holding immunization clinics across the commonwealth with extended weeknight and Saturday hours between Aug. 1 and Sept. 2 to provide vaccines at little or no cost for children through 18 years of age who are Medicaid eligible, uninsured, underinsured, or American Indian or Alaska Native:

- The cost is \$5 per child (payable by check or money order) for families above income guidelines; however, no child will be turned away because of an inability to pay.
- Parents must bring their child’s vaccination records to their scheduled appointment.
- A parent/legal guardian must accompany the child receiving immunizations.
- DOH staff will need to be notified prior to the appointment if someone other than the child’s parent/legal guardian will be accompanying him/her.
