
District Distribution

The Southcentral District of the state has reported the most rabies cases to date in 2016. The Southcentral District frequently reports the most animal rabies cases in Pennsylvania.

Raccoons have been the most frequently reported rabid animal in Pennsylvania in 2016.




Animal Rabies Cases by Animal - 2016

Slightly more animal rabies cases were reported in February 2016 than in February of the past two years.




Animal Rabies Cases by Month - 2016
