


## PM Objects

Each symbol used in the Program Mapping process stands for a type of function. The primary symbols used are shown below:


 The purple box with lines through it is a *predefined process* and is the starting point of a new program.

From this, one or more functions will flow. Most processes requiring action to be taken will use the *process* symbol  to the right. The aqua colored

 *document* symbol is used anytime a hard copy (such as a report) is created or utilized in some way.

The *data* symbol is used anytime an electronic data file is created, sent, downloaded, etc... It is the  green symbol to the right. The pink *manual input*

 symbol is used anytime a manual input, such as hand keying data, is required. The salmon colored

 triangle is the *decision* symbol and is used in a PM anytime a decision such as yes or no is made and the PM has a different flow function depending upon the decision (Yes/No).

The blue keystone shaped symbol is the *manual operation* symbol. This is used when a *manual operation other than manual input* described

above is the function. Other miscellaneous functions will have the light green  symbol to the right.
