2016 Toxicology Proficiency Testing Program Fees

All laboratories that offer any of the services listed below are required to participate in Bureau of Laboratories proficiency testing programs in order to maintain approval to provide those determinations. This requirement applies regardless of whether the determinations are performed for medical, legal, or environmental health purposes.

Each program consists of three surveys per year and each survey contains five specimens for each matrix to be analyzed. Specimens should be tested to identify and/or quantify analyte content. Further details regarding each program will be provided with the test specimens.

The Blood Alcohol and Blood Lead proficiency testing programs have been approved by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) in accordance with the federal Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments of 1988 (CLIA 1988). Participating in these programs therefore satisfies both state and federal proficiency testing requirements.
