
### April 2016 Animal Rabies Cases


### District Distribution

The Southeast area of the state has reported the most rabies cases to date in 2016. The Southeast region frequently reports a high number of animal rabies cases in Pennsylvania.

Raccoons have been the most frequently reported rabid animal in Pennsylvania in 2016.




**Animal Rabies Cases by Animal - 2016**

**Monthly Distribution 2014-2016**

Fewer animal rabies cases were reported in April 2016 than in April 2015, but counts for April 2016 are similar to April 2014.




**Animal Rabies Cases by Month - 2016**

**Three Year Trend 2014-2016**

The number of rabies cases reported to date in 2016 is slightly more than those reported in in the same time frame in 2014 and 2015.
