
January 2016 Animal Rabies Cases

The southcentral district of the state reported the most rabies cases in January 2016. The southcentral district commonly reports the most animal rabies cases in Pennsylvania.





Raccoons are the most commonly reported rabid animal in Pennsylvania in 2016.




Animal Rabies Cases by Animal - 2016

Slightly more animal rabies cases were reported in January 2016 than in January of the past two years.




Animal Rabies Cases by Month - 2016

The number of rabies cases reported in January 2016 is slightly more than those reported in January of 2014 and 2015.




Animal Rabies Cases Cumulative Totals - 2014-2016
