Funding provides immunizations to adults, infants, children and youth to reduce the incidence of vaccine-preventable diseases in the Commonwealth. The target population is all children and youth, with a particular emphasis on preschool children less than two years old. The program also coordinates the surveillance of vaccine-preventable diseases; controls disease outbreaks; assesses immunization levels; conducts professional and public education programs; and initiates, processes and evaluates the school immunization reporting system.

The Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) is a federally funded program for pregnant, breastfeeding or postpartum women; infants; and children up to age five who have nutritional risks due to poor health, inadequate diet and low income. The Department provides federal funding through local agencies that serve all sixty-seven (67) counties, which provide for the delivery of nutrition education, certification of eligibility and distribution of food instruments which are redeemed for nutritious supplemental foods to participants on a monthly basis. Foods provided include milk and/or cheese, infant formulas, cereals, juices, eggs, peanut butter, baby foods, whole grains and fruits and vegetables. These foods are rich in nutrients frequently lacking in diets of members of the target populations. The Department also has agreements with retail grocery stores who redeem WIC food instruments for WIC approved foods. The food instruments are stored on eWIC SmartCard chips and are processed through a third party vendor for redemption through the banking system to reimburse the retail stores.

Funding provided for Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity assists the Department in improving epidemiologic and laboratory surveillance systems. The primary goal of this program is to electronically link the state's infectious disease reporting sites. This linkage will ultimately improve the reporting of positive laboratory results and speed the epidemiologic investigations they trigger. The success of this surveillance is dependent upon accurate diagnostic support provided by the Department's Bureau of Laboratories, Division of Clinical Microbiology, through the performance of serologic testing, viral isolation and specimen identification. Funding will provide resources to accelerate activities around infection control assessment and response, laboratory safety, global migration, border interventions, and migrant health, and will protect the public health and safety by enhancing the capacity of public health agencies to effectively detect, respond, prevent, and control known and emerging (or re-emerging) infectious diseases.

Funding for the National Antimicrobial Resistance Monitoring Systems (NARMS) Cooperative Agreement Program to Strengthen Antibiotic Resistance Surveillance in Retail Food Specimens grant is used to improve the detection of antibiotic resistance among bacteria in food commodities, as well as expand to new sites to expand the scope of sampling.

Two contracts are funded by the National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS): The Vital Statistics Cooperative Program (VSCP) is a coalition of data providers and users at federal, state and local levels of government, whose goals are to collect, compile and disseminate health data in the most efficient and economical manner possible. The purpose of this contract is to modify the state vital statistics system and procedures to meet statistical data set tabulation requirements of NCHS. Data is provided to NCHS on a monthly basis. The National Death Index (NDI) is an information system which has the provision to locate specific death records dating back to 1979. The NDI file is used to determine the fact of death of specific individuals included in medical and health research projects and studies. Use of the NDI is restricted to health and epidemiological research. Data is provided to NCHS on a monthly basis.

Two contracts are funded by the Social Security Administration (SSA): The Vital Statistics Birth Records contract provides selected information, with parental consent, to the Social Security Administration in order to issue Social Security Numbers for newborns. This service allows Social Security Numbers to be issued more timely and without the parents having to personally visit the SSA office. The Vital Statistics Death Records contract provides the Social Security Administration with selected information from each death record containing a Social Security Number. These records are matched with Social Security benefits files in an effort to identify potential fraudulent receipt of Social Security benefits.

One contract is funded by the U.S Consumer Product Safety Commission. The Death Certification Project provides the Commission with timely information of deaths caused by or related to consumer products.
