The Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) is a federally funded program for pregnant, breastfeeding or postpartum women; infants; and children up to age five who have nutritional risks due to poor health, inadequate diet and low income. The Department provides federal funding through local agencies that serve all sixty-seven (67) counties, which provide for the delivery of nutrition education, certification of eligibility and distribution of food instruments which are redeemed for nutritious supplemental foods to participants on a monthly basis. Foods provided include milk and/or cheese, infant formulas, cereals, juices, eggs, peanut butter, baby foods, whole grains and fruits and vegetables. These foods are rich in nutrients frequently lacking in diets of members of the target populations. The Department also has agreements with retail grocery stores who redeem WIC food instruments for WIC approved foods. The food instruments are stored on eWIC SmartCard chips and are processed through a third party vendor for redemption through the banking system to reimburse the retail stores.

Funding provided for Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity assists the Department in improving epidemiologic and laboratory surveillance systems. The primary goal of this program is to electronically link the state's infectious disease reporting sites. This linkage will ultimately improve the reporting of positive laboratory results and speed the epidemiologic investigations they trigger. The success of this surveillance is dependent upon accurate diagnostic support provided by the Department's Bureau of Laboratories, Division of Clinical Microbiology, through the performance of serologic testing, viral isolation and specimen identification. Funding will provide resources to accelerate activities around infection control assessment and response, laboratory safety, global migration, border interventions, and migrant health, and will protect the public health and safety by enhancing the capacity of public health agencies to effectively detect, respond, prevent, and control known and emerging (or re-emerging) infectious diseases.

Funding for the National Antimicrobial Resistance Monitoring Systems (NARMS) Cooperative Agreement Program to Strengthen Antibiotic Resistance Surveillance in Retail Food Specimens grant is used to improve the detection of antibiotic resistance among bacteria in food commodities, as well as expand to new sites to expand the scope of sampling.
