Contact Tracing (Monthly)

- # of Cases Being Monitored Over Last 2 Weeks:
 - We've enrolled 3638 contacts in the past 14 days.

- # of Partner Organizations
 - 50 partner organizations including academic institutions, healthcare systems and providers, community-based organizations and service providers, and workforce development organizations.

- Brief Narrative Update on Regional Partnerships
 - The regional partnerships have been slowly taking shape, with many organizations and entities coming together organically to discuss contact tracing, explore coordination, and facilitate collaboration. The Southwest Consortium is scheduled to meet for its sixth meeting on Monday, July 13th. A Southcentral Consortium, formed by Partners for Better Health, has been meeting and plans to hold their second meeting on Wednesday, July 16th. The Northcentral is planning to meet on Wednesday, July 16th as well, and the Southeast, Northeast, and Northwest conversations are still taking shape. These conversations are helpful in establishing the regional contact tracing landscape and will help to facilitate more responsive coordination across regions as we enter into the Fall.
