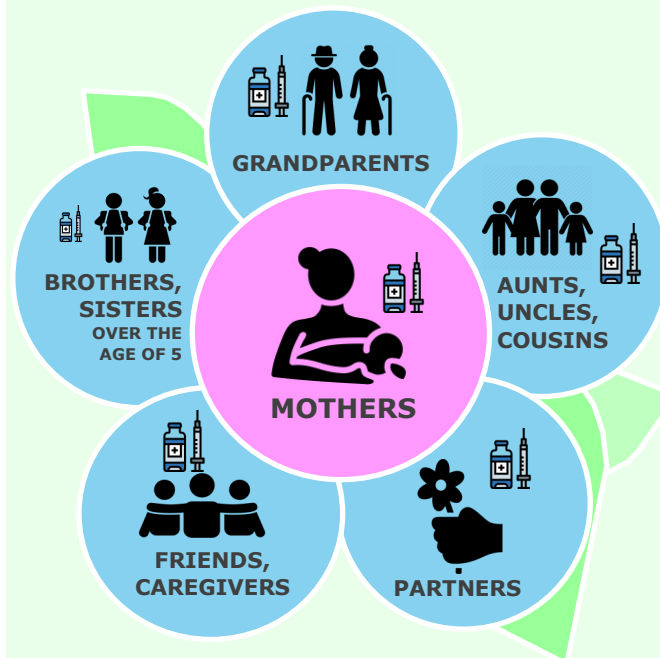


KEEPING MOTHERS AND BABIES SAFE

COCOONING TO PREVENT COVID-19 AND OTHER ILLNESSES



Babies less than 6 months old are at risk from diseases like whooping cough, the flu, and COVID-19 because they have not been exposed to them in the past and can not be vaccinated against them for protection.

Cocooning is a way to protect babies from catching diseases from the people around them – people like their parents, siblings, grandparents, friends, babysitters, childcare providers, and healthcare providers.

Once people close to the baby are vaccinated, they are less likely to spread contagious diseases to the baby.
