<p>Decontamination/Clothing Removal</p>	<p>(1 of 2) Think you were exposed to lewisite? Remove clothing, wash entire body with soap & water, & call 911 for immediate medical care #EventHashtag</p>	<p>Think you were exposed to lewisite? Remove clothing, wash entire body with soap and water, and call 9-1-1 for immediate medical care. Any exposed clothing that has to be pulled over the head should be cut off the body instead of pulled over the head.</p>	

(2 of 2) Any exposed clothing that has to be pulled over the head should be cut off the body instead of pulled over the head #EventHashtag

When helping someone exposed remove their clothing, avoid touching contaminated areas & remove as quickly as possible #EventHashtag

If exposed to lewisite: as quickly as possible, wash any lewisite from your skin with large amounts of soap and water #EventHashtag

If your eyes are burning or your vision is blurred, rinse your eyes with plain water for 10 to 15 minutes #EventHashtag

If exposed to lewisite & you wear contacts: remove them after washing hands & put them with contaminated clothing. Don't re-use #EventHashtag
