

# Community Survey



The Pennsylvania Department of Health (PA DOH) is conducting a follow-up community Assessment of Chemical Exposure (ACE) survey to understand the health impacts of the February 3, 2023, train derailment in East Palestine, Ohio.

## Who Can Participate?

Residents of PA who may have been impacted by the February 3 Norfolk Southern train derailment in East Palestine, Ohio. You do not need to have taken the first survey to participate in this follow-up survey. There are separate surveys for Ohio residents and PA first responders.

## How Can You Take the Survey?

You can complete the survey by:

The survey includes questions on:

- Your location during and following the derailment
- Your health status after the train derailment
- Medical care you received
- Ongoing health concerns or needs
- Animal health
- Gardening habits
