Pennsylvania and United States, 1950-2019

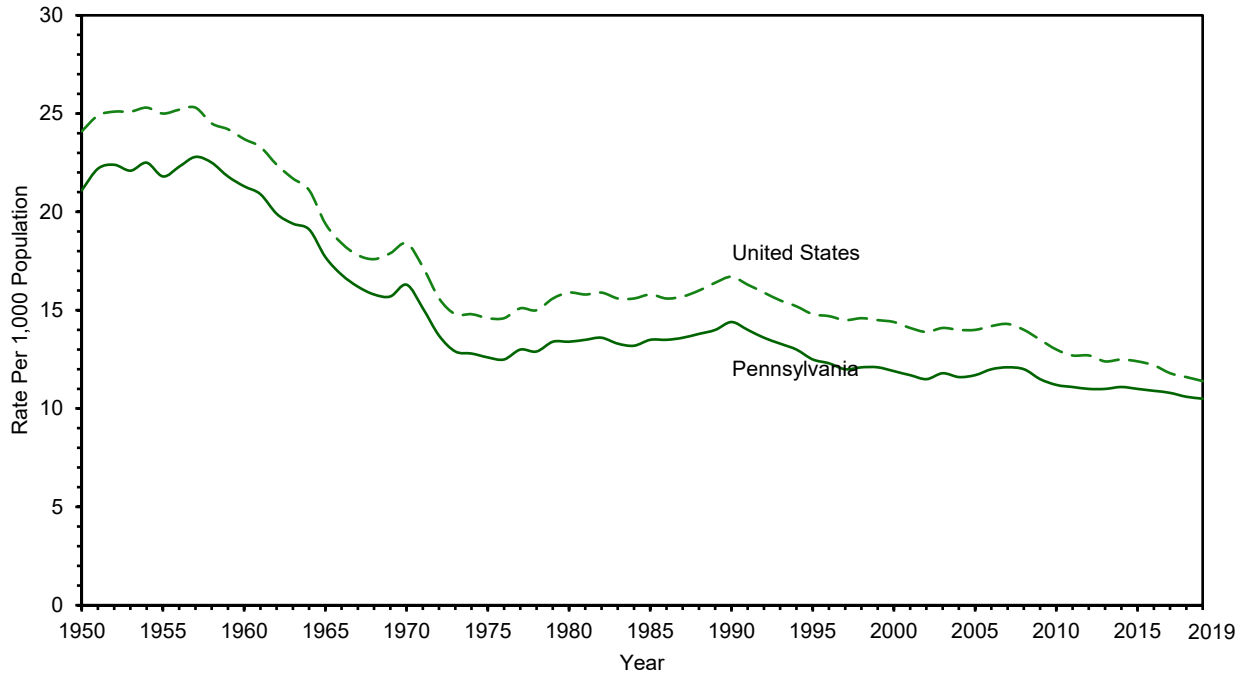

Pennsylvania and United States, 1950-2019

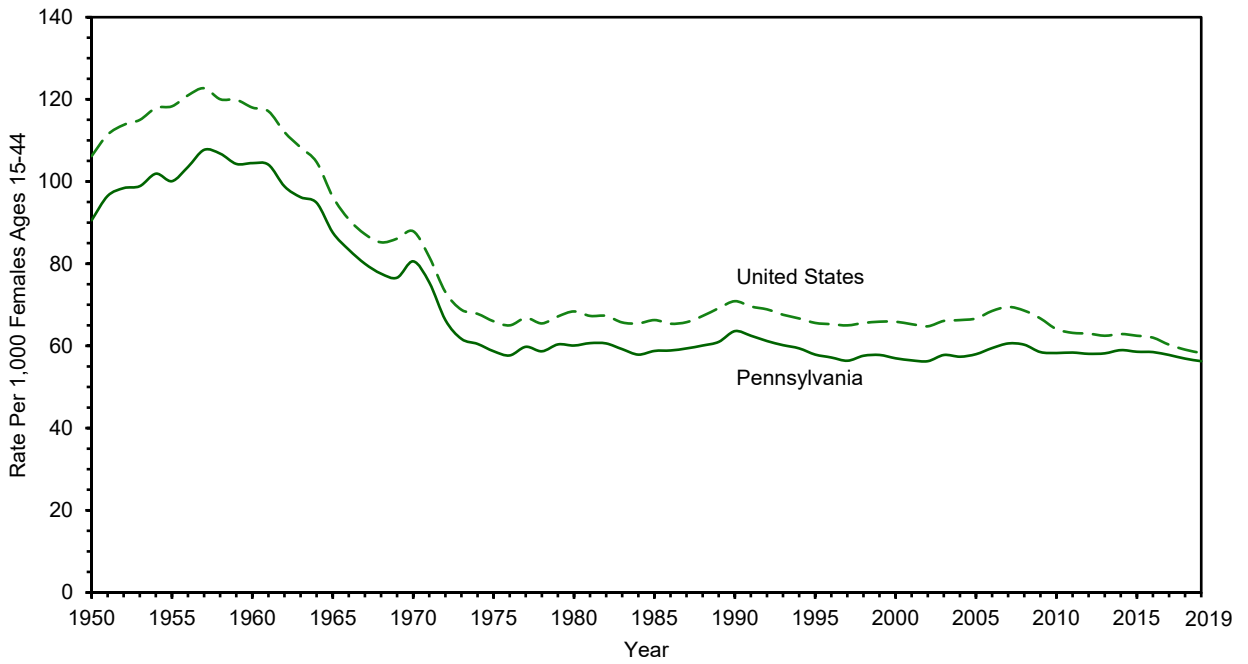

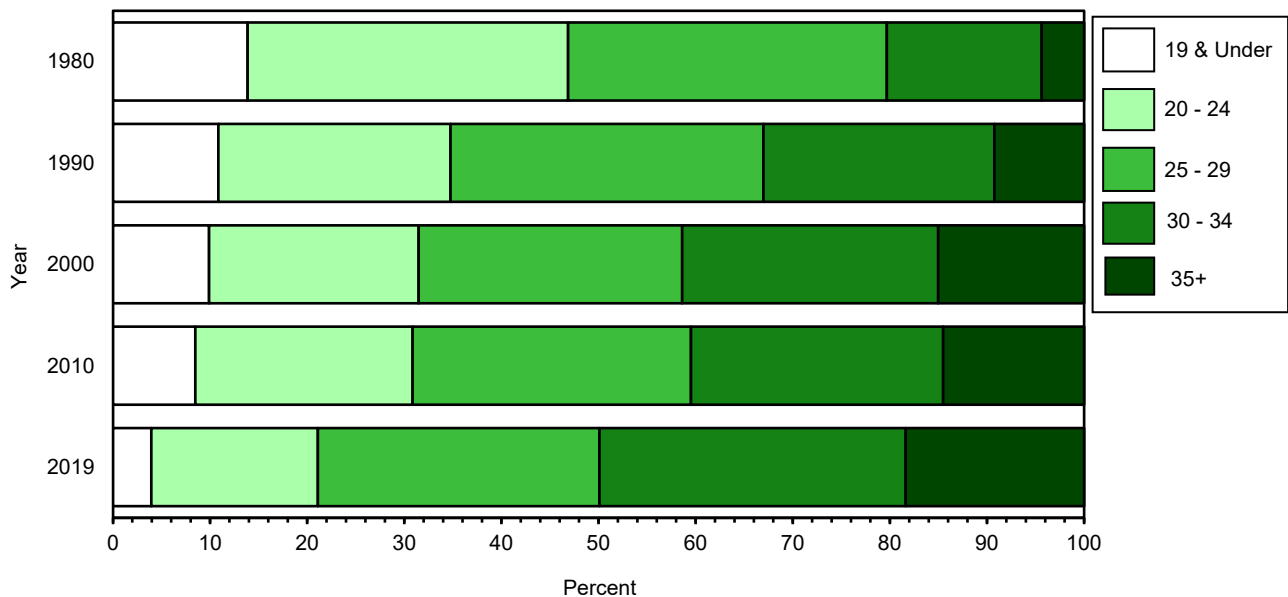

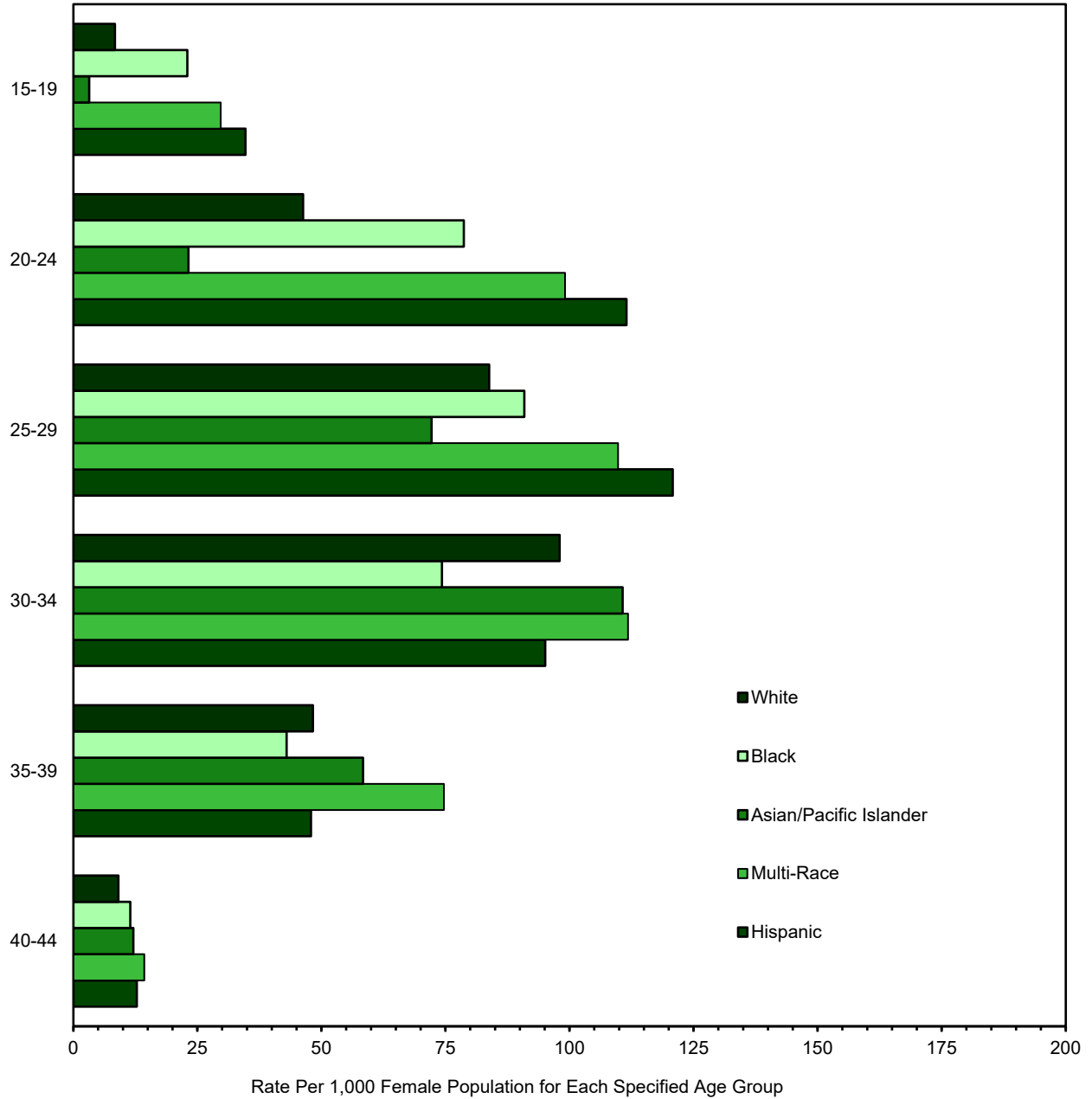

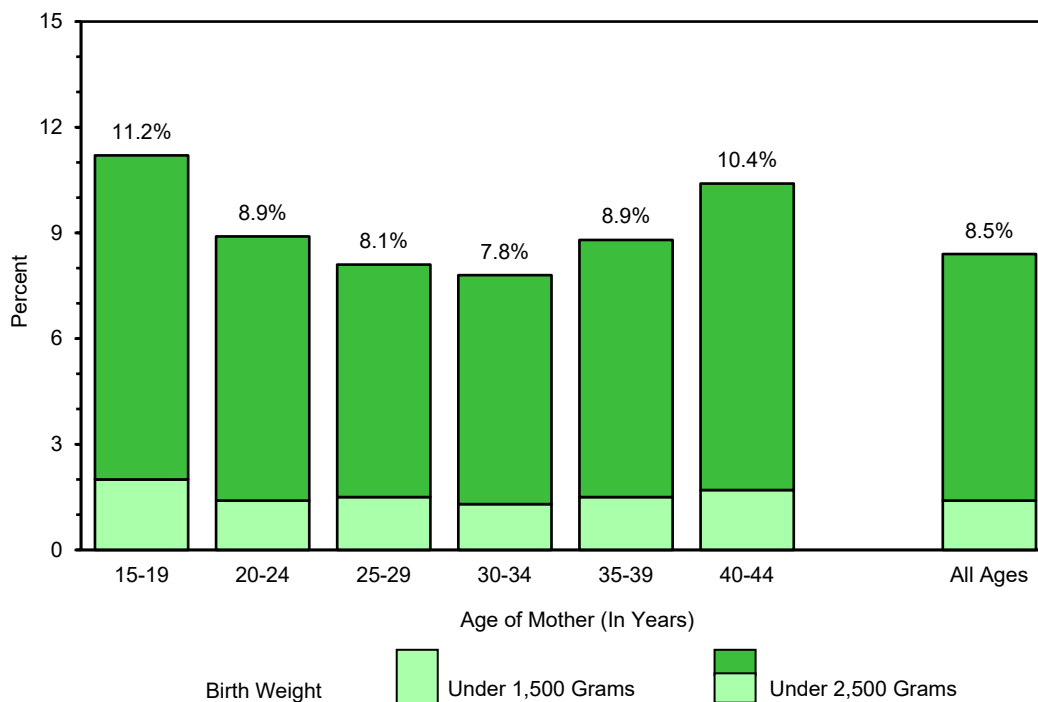

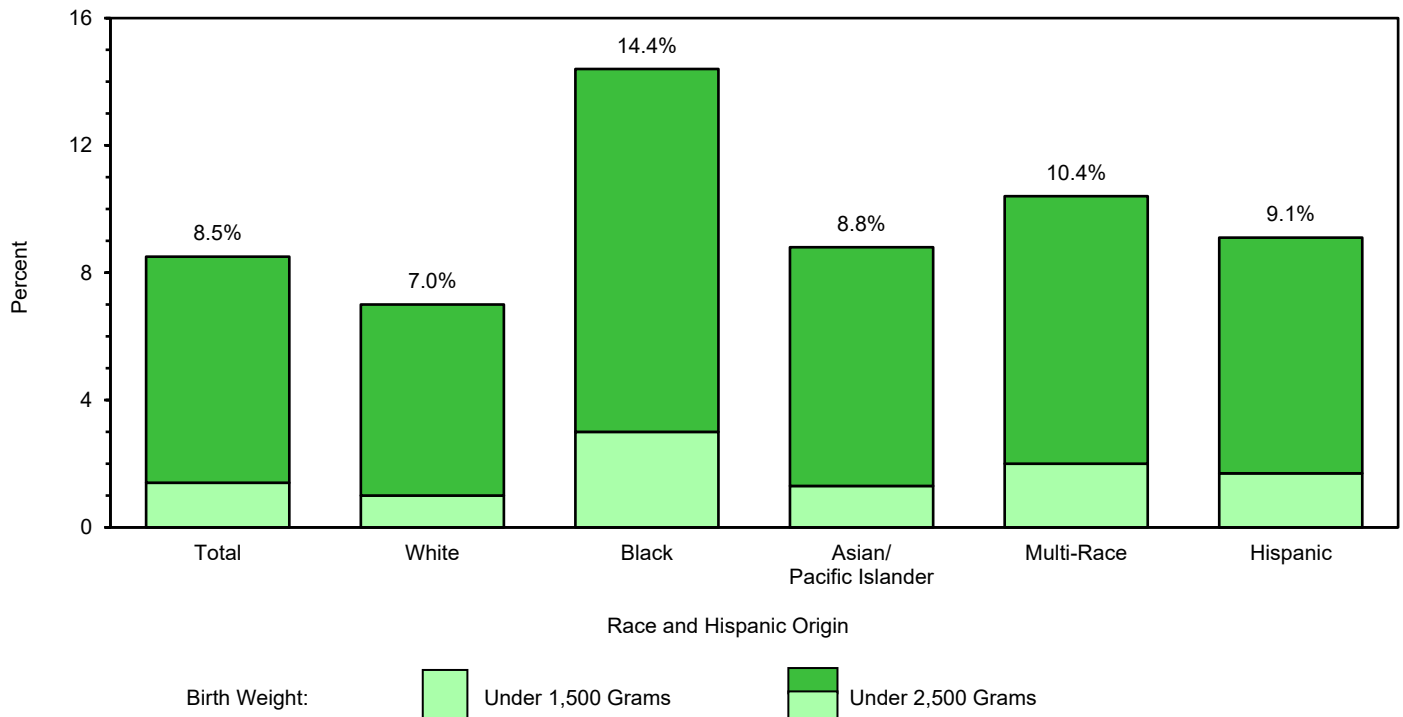

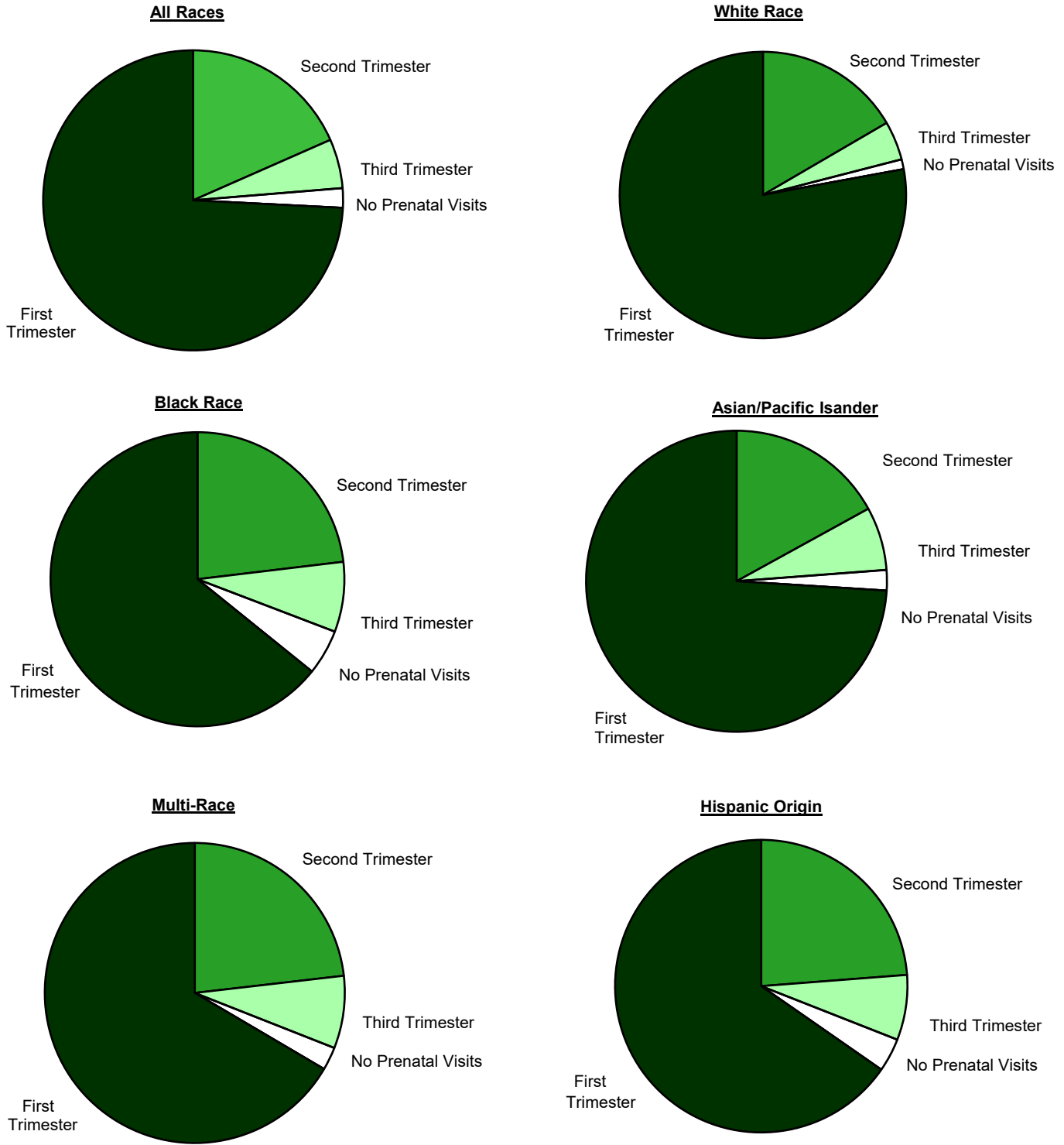

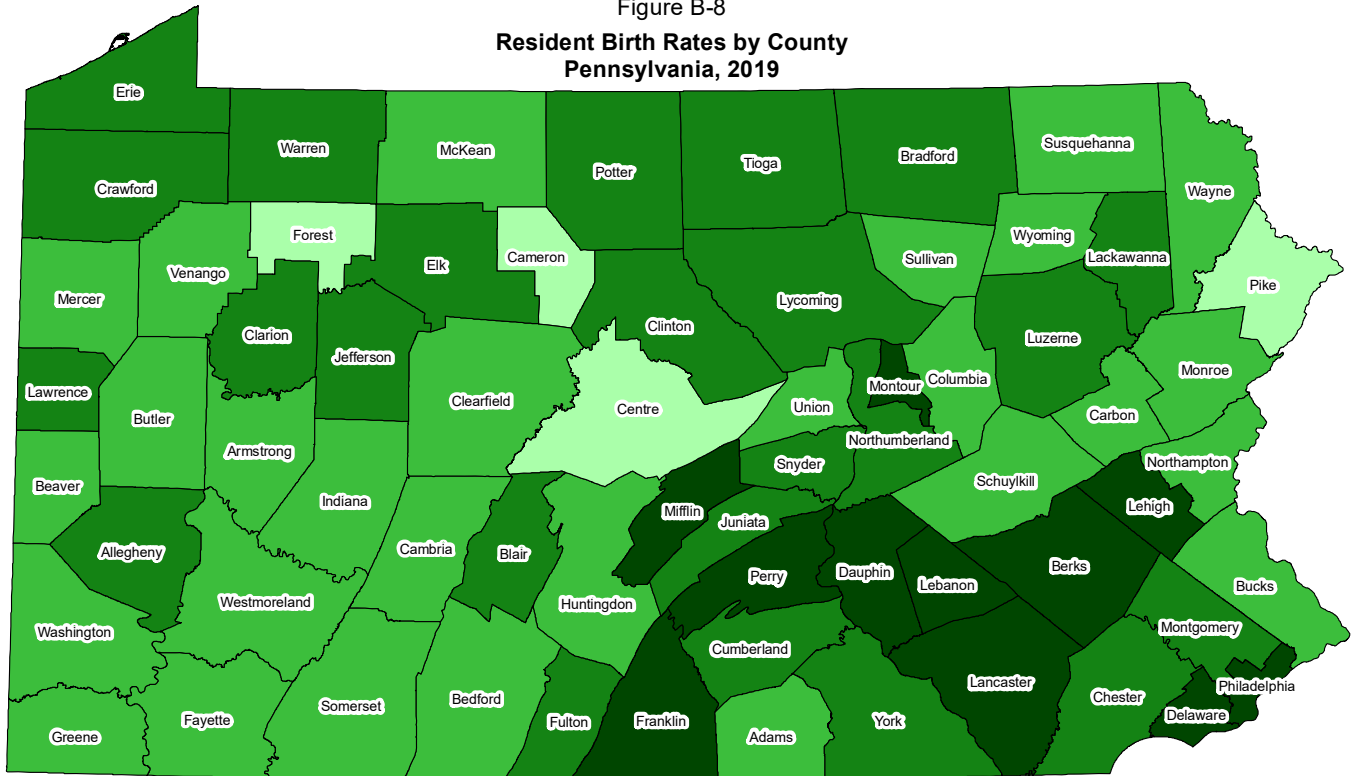

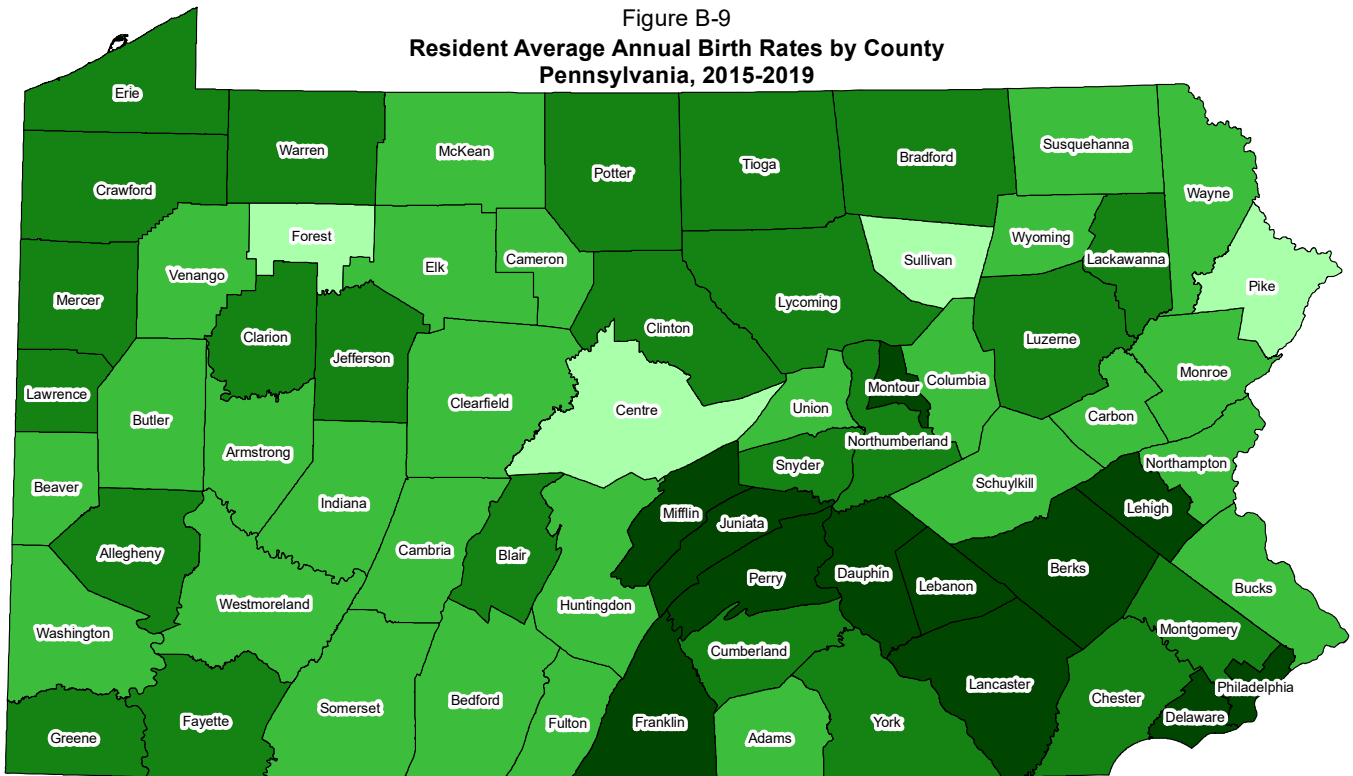

 Pennsylvania, 2019**



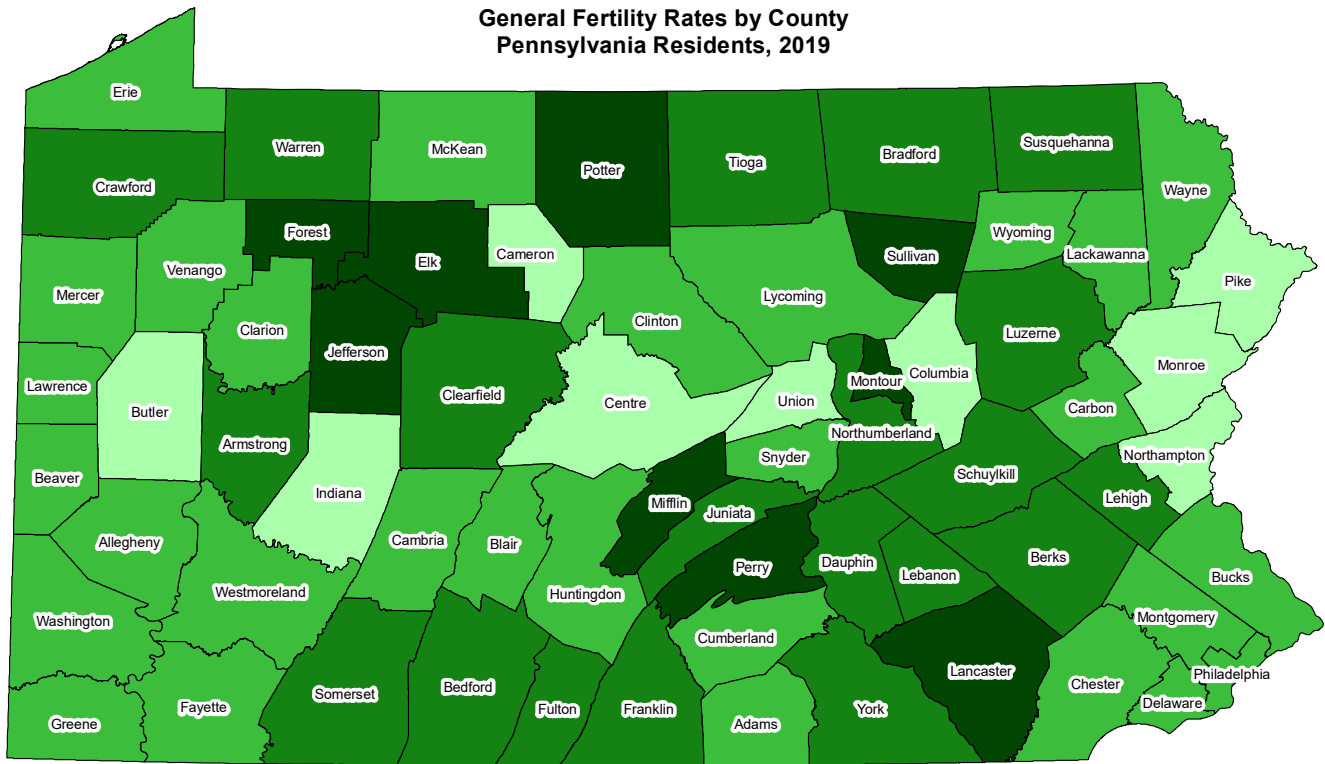

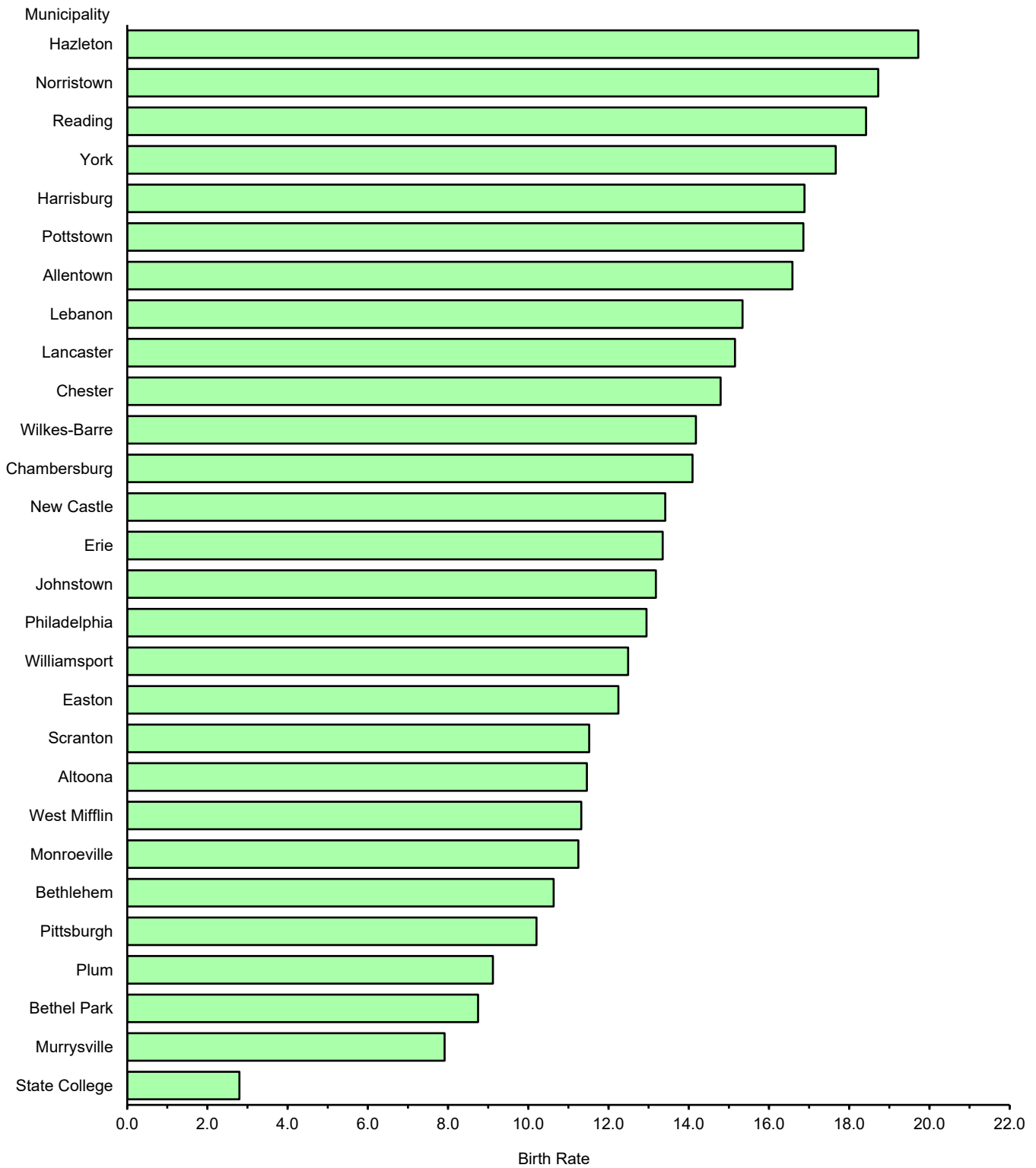

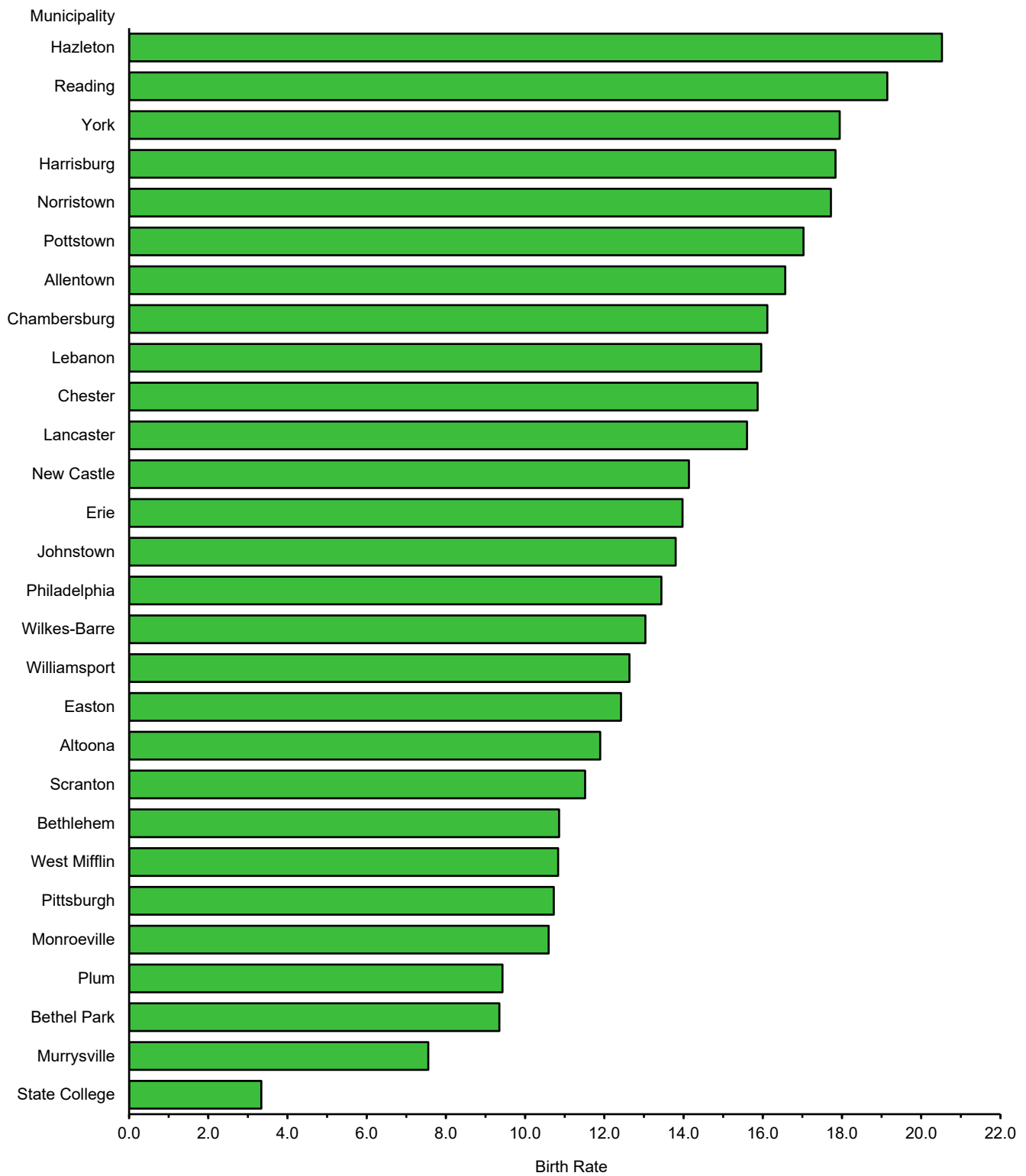
