

## Donor and/or Donor Families

The Organ Donor Incidental Expenses Family Benefit Plan (ODIEFBP) provides reimbursement benefits for certain incidental expenses incurred by eligible vital organ donors and/or donor families. This plan was established by Pennsylvania Act 102, which increases awareness and education of the need for organ transplantation and encourages organ donation.

## Eligibility:

Donors of vital organs, such as:

- Heart
- Liver
- Lung
- Kidney
- Pancreas
- Small bowel
- Large bowel
- Stomach

Family members include those persons who travel with the living donor to provide support to him/her during the transplantation process.

A limited amount of up to \$300\* per family for lodging and meal expenses will be covered by the ODIEFBP, regardless of family size or income. Arrangements at select hotels for lodging and meals will be facilitated by a hospital representative. No money is exchanged with the donor family. All transactions will take place between the hospitals or hotels and the Department of Health.
