#### Introduction

Act 102 of 1994 established the Governor Robert P. Casey Memorial Organ and Tissue Donation Awareness Trust Fund (Trust Fund), Organ Donation Advisory Committee (ODAC) and Pennsylvania's Organ and Tissue Donation Awareness Program (OTDA). In October 2018, Act 90 was signed into law. With the changes that resulted from the passage of Act 90, Pennsylvania's Anatomical Gift Law received significant updates.

Pursuant to Section 8622 (c.1)(5), the advisory committee shall submit a report concerning the advisory committee's activities and progress to the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives by October 31 of each even-numbered year. A final written report under this section shall be adopted at a public meeting.

The attached report was reviewed and adopted at the Organ Donation Advisory Committee meeting held on Aug. 6, 2020. For questions regarding this report, please contact the Department of Health, Office of Legislative Affairs.

The Organ Donation Advisory Committee has the following roles:

- Advises the secretary of health on matters relating to the administration of the Governor Robert P. Casey Memorial Organ and Tissue Awareness Trust Fund;
- Reviews progress in the area of organ and tissue donation in the commonwealth;
- Recommends education and awareness training programs;
- Recommends priorities in expenditures from the fund;
- Recommends legislation as it deems necessary to fulfill the statutory chapter on anatomical gifts; and
- Submits progress report to the General Assembly.

Following are the activities and progress of the committee for the period of 2018-2020:

- Advocating for updated legislation
- Addressing funding concerns by exploring creative funding options via partnerships and grant opportunities
- Exploring mechanisms to increase donor designation rates including:
  - o Partnerships with pharmacies and other community level providers
  - Better engagement of potential donors on the PennDOT website
  - Organ donation tabling events at high volume/low donor DMV locations
  - Projects with colleges and universities
- Promoting significant organ donation events such as:
  - Donate Life Month
  - Blue and Green Day
  - PA Donor Day (January 8<sup>th</sup>)
- Making recommendations to PennDOT regarding data collection and reporting of donor designation status
- Making recommendations to PennDOT and the Department of Health on website edits
- Reviewing and making recommendations for funded projects such as the education and awareness project administered by Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) and the statewide media campaign
  - O PDE, through a subcontract, administers the organ and tissue donation awareness (OTDA) project which seeks to help secondary students consider critical issues that surround organ and tissue donation. Teens can then make an informed decision about donor designation when obtaining their driver's license.
  - The OTDA program also provides educational opportunities for students and educators and provides mini grants to schools to spread awareness about organ and tissue donation by integrating organ, eye and tissue donation topics across the school curriculum. On average, 12 mini grants are awarded annually.
- Reviewing and offering suggested edits to the Department of Health budget documents
- Developing relationships with potential partners, particularly those with areas of synergy, such as the National Kidney Foundation

- Guiding the implementation of Act 90
  - The implementation of Act 90 required edits to the Departments of Health and Transportation websites. This expanded information enhanced web content on the important topic of organ donation and also provided the opportunity for online donations to the Trust Fund by establishing a hyperlink to facilitate donation.
  - The Department of Health receives nearly 1400 visitors to the organ donation webpage annually while the Donate Life PA website receives nearly 54,000 unique visitors annually.
- Reviewing and discussing pressing state and federal legislation and initiatives such as the president's "Advancing American Kidney Health" initiative
- Reviewing and commenting on proposed rule CMS-3380 pertaining to Organ Procurement Organizations (OPOs) Conditions for Coverage.

A significant amount of committee time was also spent planning an event celebrating the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Governor Robert P. Casey Memorial Organ and Tissue Awareness Trust Fund. It was anticipated that this event would bring needed attention to the topic of organ donation. Unfortunately, this event was canceled due to COVID-19.

As of March 31, 2020, the donor designation rate in Pennsylvania is 49.54 percent. By way of comparison, the designation rate in 2019 was 49 percent and the rate in 2018 was 47.8 percent.
