Easton Area Community Center (EACC)

The EACC has been serving the West Ward community for over 60 years, including boxing great Larry Holmes and Olympic Wrestler Bobby Weaver when they were in their youth. The center hosts many community events and ongoing programs, especially aimed at local youth. It has its own indoor basketball court, wrestling room, Cops and Kids reading room and a large general use room with kitchen facilities.

Dutchtown Park

This hidden gem of a “pocket park” is also known as the Walnut Street Park, tucked away on the 600 block of Walnut St. The park has picnic tables and a Tot Lot where younger children can play and serves as a quiet spot to sit and relax in this scenic section of the West Ward.

The Lot Spot

Paxinosa Elementary School

This building was the original Easton High School. High school football games are still played across the street at Cottingham Stadium. It also once served as the Easton Middle School for 6th and 7th grade. The school currently serves around 690 students in grades K through 5.
