

- Brentwood Park, Park Drive
 - The crown jewel of our municipality has recently received an investment of over \$5 million. This 28-acre site includes a state-of-the-art stadium, a dek hockey rink, multiple athletic fields, a community-built playground and our beloved public pool.
- Holleman House
 This eye-catching structure was erected in 1920. It has been recognized by the Pittsburgh History & Landmarks Foundation as an elaborate illustration of the California bungalow style of architecture.
- H.P Malick House
 Originally constructed in 1909, this pastoral estate is one of our community's most iconic properties. The home was the subject of the book "The Demon of Brownsville Road," which documents purported paranormal activity at the site.
- Moore Elementary School
 Six generations of residents have passed through the classrooms of this classic institutional structure, which presently provides primary education to children from the southern half of the Borough.
- Brentwood Towne Square
 This spacious development replaced the antiquated Brentwood-Whitehall Shopping Center in 2003. It contains a multitude of businesses and it conveys a Main Street ambiance while providing ample parking.
