- Jermyn High School
 - Jermyn High School opened in January 1937. Some years later, it became the Jermyn Elementary School and was then transformed to serve as the Jermyn Borough Building.
- Sterling's Pharmacy
 Sterling's Pharmacy, formerly Grave's Drug Store, has been a drug store in the borough for over 100 years."
- First National Bank of Jermyn
 First National Bank of Jermyn was founded in 1902. It is now known as and operated by Community Bank, N.A.
- Battenberg Furniture Store
 Founded in 1881, Battenberg Furniture Store has been continuously run by the same family, the oldest operating store in Jermyn Borough.
- Windsor Inn
 Formerly known as the "Carpenter's Farmers' Hotel" and "Hotel Windsor," the Windsor Inn was built in 1889. The very first First-Aid class ever taught in the USA, by Dr. Matthew Shields in 1899, was at this location.
- Rushbrook Creek
 The Rushbrook Creek flood of 2003 was the worst natural disaster to ever occur in Jermyn. Millions of dollars in personal property, roadways, and creek bank were lost. The loss has led to the much anticipated \$4M+ Rushbrook Creek Flood Protection Project that is scheduled to begin in 2021 or 2022.
