

This notice is to provide an update on the eVitals implementation. Text shown in **red** font indicates updated information since this State Registrar Notice was initially issued.

The Bureau of Health Statistics and Registries (BHSR) will be implementing a new vital records management system for death reporting **on OCT 7** of 2024. This system, known as eVitals, will support the electronic registration and records management of both birth and death records, replacing the DAVE system.

eVitals is designed to modernize the electronic registration and management of Pennsylvania's vital records. This modernization effort includes improvements to the registration of vital events including expanded integration with third-party software; improvements in managing Pennsylvania's 25 million vital records; integration with a newly designed website to order birth and death certificates; and an improved in-person experience when ordering at one of our six Vital Records public offices.

Facilities and users of the eVitals system **must** establish a Keystone Login as required under Commonwealth policy, [ITP-SEC039, Keystone Login and Identity Proofing](#). In addition to establishing a Keystone Login, each organization reporting into eVitals **should already have completed** an eVitals Facility Registration form. **Facilities which have not yet done so must complete the facility registration immediately by following the link below.**

**Facility Administrator Training will take place on-line beginning four months prior to implementation. Individual User Training for certifiers will take place on-line beginning 60 days prior to implementation. No later than 30 days prior to the implementation date, the State Registrar will issue specific transition instructions to execute the cut-over from DAVE to eVitals.**
