1	Jacob Chalfin, Chair, introduced himself. Committee members, and DOH staff introduced themselves.
	Public attendees introduced themselves. Jacob Chalfin, reviewed Agenda.
2	Dr. Cooper moved to accept the meeting minutes of April 16, 2020. Dr. Caldera second. No discussion.
	No opposition or abstentions. The motion passed unanimously.
3	Update on 2020-2021 Request for Application (RFA)
	 The Department has received the estimated amount for the 2020-2021 fiscal year. The actual fund amount will be known in mid to late spring.
	 The actual fund amount will be known in mid-to-late spring. The funds for the SCRAC RFA will combine the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 state fiscal year
	funding, as per Appendix H, for a total of \$2 million. This was approved in the previous
	meeting.
	• The RFA was drafted and submitted to Procurement for review on September 11 and is going
	through the editing process.
4	Follow up to last meeting
	a) Review of SCRAC Applications Procedural Overview
	ORAU outlined its peer review process which would result in them providing the SCRAC with a
	rank order of the proposal scores.
	• Jacob Chalfin, expressed that the preference is for ORAU to provide a ranking of all proposals
	regardless of what tier they fall in.
	• Drs Boninger and Fischer suggested that a secondary review of each grant propsal would not
	be needed. Instead SCRAC will evaluate the proposal rankings to assess consistency of scores
	and relevance of proposals based on RFA criteria.
	Meghna Patel reminded the group that committee members from those institutions that
	have submitted applications will need to recuse themselves from any review or scoring
	activity.
	• Dr. Boninger suggested that a second committee could be formed comprised of outside
	experts to review the proposals as a way to address conflicts of interest.
	 Jacob Chalfin, agreed to review minutes and present a more simplified process to Committee
	around the issues related to the review of the applications and conflicts of interest.

	 A fillable form was provided to Committee members, this should be completed, saved as a
	PDF and returned to the Health Research Office.

	 Year three funding amount will be \$1 million.
	• Jacob Chalfin suggested reverting back to original Tier grant amounts of: \$75,000 (Tier one),
	\$150,000 (Tier two) and \$250,000 (Tier three).
	Alex Charleton made a motion to adopt the Tier levels identified for 2021-2022. Dr.
	<i>Abramoff</i> second. No discussion. No opposition or abstentions. The motion passed unanimously.
